**RULES:** All shooting will be governed by the NSRA Rules. Any dispute will be decided by three or more members of the BCRA Committee, or their elected deputies.

**RECEPTION:** On arrival report for registration and collection of your targets.

**TARGETS:** Targets will be NSRA 1989 series

**TARGET CLIPS:** Target clips are not provided at the range. Competitors must provide at least 12 bulldog-type clips for securing targets and backers to the frames.

**SQUADDING:** All details will be of 20 minutes duration with a further 10 minutes for target changing and for preparation of your equipment. Please note that shooting will commence at the time stated for each detail and you **MUST** be ready to go on to the firing point at least 10 minutes before this time.

**RESULTS:** All scores will be displayed in the stats office as quickly as possible. **COMPETITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THEIR SCORES ARE CORRECTLY RECORDED BEFORE LEAVING THE MEETING.**

**CHALLENGES:** A score may be challenged on payment of £1.00, which will be refunded if the challenge is upheld. No score may be challenged after the close of the meeting.

**TIES:** Ties will be decided in favour of the better score at the longer range. If still tied, then by countback starting with the last card at the longer range. If still tied then by use of graduated gauges, by half card, starting with the last half card at the longer range.

**REFRESHMENTS:** A good range of refreshments will be on sale.

**CLASSIFICATION:** Any competitor having entered a Bucks Open Meeting last year need not submit an average. Any new competitors must return an up-to-date declaration of their current short range average (15, 20 or 25 yds). This must be certified by the Secretary or Captain of the competitor's club. The onus rests on the competitor to ensure a correct declaration. The meeting committee reserves the right to reclassify a competitor at any time.

Classification will be based on the following averages:-

Class A - 98.5 and over      Class B - 96.0 - 98.4

Class C - 92.5 - 95.9      Class D under 92.5

**LEFT HANDED SHOOTERS:** There will be no special provision for left handed shooters. You are reminded that the bays are marked. You are asked to keep between these lines and not to encroach onto your neighbours firing point.
